
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State Representative Joshua D. Kail 15th Legislative District

NOT YOUR FIRST RODEO?

(You have renewed your PA Real Estate License at least once)

• 1.5 Hours—Property Management

2 Hours —Advertising

Compliance with the Tax Reform Act of 1993 requires that the portion of dues attributable to lobbying and political activities at the State and Federal levels of government be considered nondeductible for income tax purposes. This nondeductible portion must be disclosed to members on their dues invoice each year.

For 2020, with dues at \$150 per member, NAR computes 38 percent or \$57 to be nondeductible for the member's income tax purposes due to NAR lobbying efforts. Please note that the entire \$35 Consumer Advertising Campaign special assessment qualifies as fully deductible

In addition, contributions (including member dues) to NAR are not tax deductible as charitable contributions. However, they may be tax deductible under other provisions of the Internal Revenue Code.

Remember, for those of you who may combine both the dues (\$150) and Consumer Advertising assessment (\$35) into one line on your dues, you need to make sure your members know that the non-deductibility percentage applies only to the \$150, not to \$185. The \$35 is fully deductible.
