SOUTHWEST FIELD REPORT

The Field Report is published by the PAR Field Program which provides 28 local associations across the state with government affairs representation.

Call-for-Action – Congratulations to the **Butler County Association**, **Greater Allegheny-Kiski Area Board** and **Washington-Greene Association** for hitting 20 percent on the NAR flood insurance Call-for-Action. NFIP has been reauthorized for four additional months, keep up the great work!

Monitoring Ordinances – The Butler County Association and Greater Allegheny-Kiski Area Board provided testimony to Saxonburg borough officials at their July meeting. Testimony addressed the concerns of a proposed sewer ordinance, which would require a certified plumber inspect home sewer lines. This proposed ordinance would affect every property in the area within the first six months, and thereafter only when a property is being sold. The testimony offered questions and concerns as to the definition of a certified plumber, since the commonwealth of Pennsylvania offers no certification for plumbers. City officials agreed to not pursue this ordinance until further research can be done. 2019 REALTOR DUES

Later this month you will receive an invoice from your broker for 2019 REALTOR Dues. REALTOR[®] dues are to paid online **if you are using a credit card**. Please follow the instructions below to pay your 2019 dues:

- 1. Go to www.realtor.org
- 2. Click on **PAY DUES**
- 3. **Sign in** using your username and password, if you do not have a username and password w/NAR then be prepared with your NRDS number* to do so.
- 4. Click on MY INVOICE
- 5. You will see "Member Invoicing and Billing Year 2019" Click on **PAY MY 2019 INVOICE**

PAR will be processing RPAC contributions when you pay your 2019 dues. They have set the level of donation at \$25.00 which is what most associations collect; **HOWEVER** you are able to adjust that amount to \$15.00 which is the investment level that BCAR has suggested in the past.

Members that are paying by check or with cash can submit payment via mail or drop off at the BCAR office. Invoices can be downloaded from our website, www.mybcar.com.

If you are a secondary member paying with a credit card, please call the BCAR office to process your credit card or mail a check made payable to: BCAR.

REALTOR[®] Emeritus Qualification Changes

The REALTOR[®] Emeritus program is a special membership status honoring those REALTORS[®] who have maintained their membership for 40 years or more. Emeritus members receive a certificate and pin to show their status, payment of National Association dues is waived for the remainder of their membership, and they are exempt from the Code of Ethics Training requirement.

FOR 2019 ONLY, members may qualify for Emeritus status if they

1) Have held membership in the National Association as a REALTOR[®], REALTOR-ASSOCIATE[®], or both, for a cumulative period of forty (40) years;

AND

2) have completed at least one (1) year of service at the National, state or local level.

Beginning in 2020, the service qualification will change so that at least one (1) year of service** at the National level only will be accepted for Emeritus status. Service at the state or local level will not be considered.

* "Service" is defined as serving as an officer, director, committee member, federal political coordinator, president's liaison or regional coordinator to a country with which NAR holds a reciprocal agreement.

> 2019 is your last opportunity to apply for REALTOR® Emeritus status with the state or local service requirement.
